Teaching Three: *The Truth about Everything*

Matthew 7.1-5

'Do not judge, so that you may not be judged. For with the judgment you make you will be judged, and the measure you give will be the measure you get. Why do you see the speck in your neighbor's eye, but do not notice the log in your own eye? Or how can you say to your neighbor, "Let me take the speck out of your eye", while the log is in your own eye? You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your neighbor's eye.

Our Common Confessions:

1. Everyone is broken and is in need of healing. Jesus offers us healing for our brokenness.
2. Everyone is lost and in need of a home. Jesus offers us a home in the heart of God surrounded by a faith family.
3. ***Everyone is tempted to fake it and needs to become real. Jesus invites us to face the truth about everything.***
